


Main transport used for longer journeys (shown with approximate journey times)

The theme of Ao no Za is how the story of the land still carries echoes of the Jomon culture into the modern age. The lobby features an 8-metre high wall symbolising the interwoven layers of Jomon culture, Ainu culture, and the modern age through the flow of time.

The rooms here are exquisite, with the blues of the water reverberating through the decor. Each room features its own indoor jet bath and private outdoor onsen.

Dive into superb cuisine in the seasonal kaiseki meals carefully prepared here, crafted using only the freshest ingredients. Or, perhaps try some teppanyaki! Finish up your evening in the elegant bar.

For ultimate relaxation, head to the spa where you can enjoy a wide range of treatments using luxury products.

A number of experiences are also available to help you delve into the historic local culture, including indigo dyeing, tea ceremony, and a traditional Ainu clothing location photo shoot. Historical artefacts can also be found around the hotel, and much of the decor is a rather large nod to the rich culture of this area.



Spend the day exploring this stunning area with your guide today.

Enjoy a trip around Lake Shikotsu, the most northern lake in Japan that does not freeze in winter, and also its second-deepest. Spend the day exploring the small shops located around the edges of the lake as well as enjoying the lake's natural beauty. For most of the year, lake boat rides are available, so take advantage of this to truly get a feel for this beautiful area.

Your driver will meet you again this morning and today you'll set off to explore the Lake Shikotsu National Park.

At the northern shores of the lake stands Marukoma Onsen, a ryokan with unique hot spring baths that are also open to nonstaying visitors. The baths are located right along the lake shore and are connected to the lake by small canals, allowing for a certain exchange between the pool's hot water and the lake's cool water. Moreover, their water level changes according to the lake's water level and can be uncharacteristically high for onsen pools outside of winter. The ryokan has also conventional hot spring pools, all of which are gender segregated. After exploring the lake area, head on to visit the Shiraoi Porotokotan Ainu Village. Shiraoi lies in between Noboribetsu and Tomakomaishi, about an hour's drive from Lake Shikotsu and was once the site of many Ainu villages. It is now a famous spot for introducing Ainu culture. While performances of ancient Ainu dances can also be viewed here, the most outstanding feature of Shiraoi Porotokotan is the Ainu Museum, a significant outdoor museum that is located on this site.

With multiple homes exhibited outdoors, the Ainu Museum reproduces the appearance of an Ainu village. The facility also features spaces that are home to bears and the Hokkaido dogs that were an essential part of Ainu life, a botanical garden growing edible and medicinal plants, and a cafe serving Ainu food. It offers a close-up experience of the way of life of the Ainu people, who lived in harmony with nature.

scene with local live bands playing concerts in the city's old warehouses. Locals often call Otaru "the Venice of Hokkaido", not only because of the canal but also because the city is famous for its hand-blown glassware. Be sure to browse the shops offering everything from glass table lamps to glass fountain pens!

To make the most of your trip, we suggest a fresh sushi lunch in one of the many seafood restaurants and then follow it up with a slice of the famous "Double Fromage" cheesecake in the Le Tao cafe.

### Day 8



Today, enjoy a full-day private tour of the stunning Lake Akan.

Lake Akan is famous the world over for its "marimo", rounded moss balls that are found in very few other areas on the planet. Conserving the marimo has become a priority for the local government as they are not only important to the indigenous Ainu population, but the other major marimo colony in Iceland has diminished significantly in recent years.

The Akan area also has some great onsen, so you will have the opportunity to try an onsen bath.

Today we recommend heading out in your rental car and driving to the other side of Akan Mashu National Park to see Lake Mashu (Mashuko). The natural scenery is stunning and the mountains reflect off the crystal clear waters of the lake. You might like to stop by one of the observatories around the lake. The area itself is lovely for some leisurely walking.

You might like to stop off at the neighbouring lake (Lake Kussharo) for Sunayu Beach, where onsen water surfaces right under the sand. You can dig a hole in the beach and make your own onsen bath!

On the opposite (north) side of Lake Kussharo is the Bihoro Pass, from where you can see some stunning panoramic views of the lake and surrounding mountains.

## Drive to New Chitose Airport at leisure

On arrival at New Chitose Airport please return your rental car before making your way to your hotel, which is a 10-minute walk away.
