
In a Nutshell

Day 3	TOKYO - KYOTO After breakfast set off on the Bullet train to Kyoto. You'll be met on arrival and taken to see some of the famous sights in the North West of the city. You'll be visiting the iconic Golden Pavilion and Ryoanji Zen Garden before ending the day at nearby Ninnaji Temple, which houses one of Kyoto's loveliest gardens. From there, head on to Gion, where you should be able to catch sight of some of Kyoto's apprentice geisha on their way to lessons. From Gion, continue to Yasaka-jinja Shrine and into Maruyama Park. Day 5	KYOTO – NARA - KYOTO Take a day trip out of Kyoto to nearby Nara, Japan's ancient capital and famous for Todaiji temple and its Great Buddha. Day 6	KYOTO – TAKAYAMA Set off on the Bullet train from Kyoto and head east to Nagoya, where you'll change to the Express train to Takayama. The largest village in the area is Ogimachi, which has a good look-out over the town. Many of the houses are open to the public as museums.
